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I originally attributed this song to Abbi Spinner, and the version here is as I learned it from her and Magnus. I later discovered that Imani was the one who brought this one to earth. It was originally written to be played with the three beat *jun-jun* pattern*, but I later arranged it to use the *Gun Gun go-do-go* pattern which I also later learned is associated with the *orisha* (spirit) *Ogun*. His pattern is a get-up-and-get-moving kind of energy appropriate to the feel of this song. I wanted to use an African rhythm to honor (however coincidentally) both these ladies, who both drum in the afro-caribbean tradition. (KTS, 1995)
